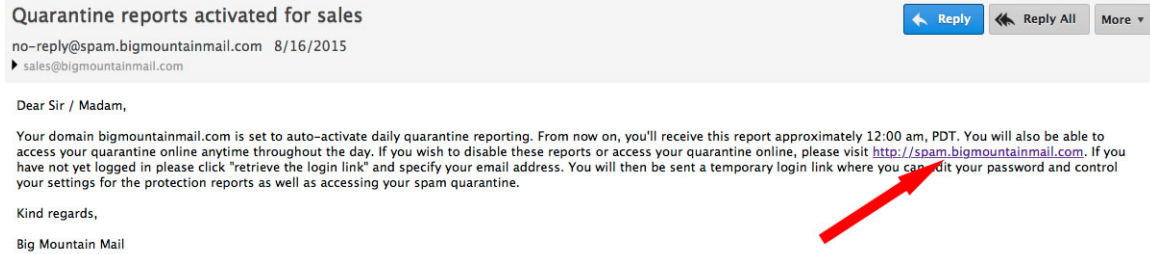


Big Mountain Spam Quarantine Setup

Welcome to the Big Mountain Spam Quarantine. Once your domain has been setup on our spam firewall, the system will automatically enable your spam quarantine. However, until you create an account, you will not be able to access your quarantine online. Upon the first spam message the system receives, the system will automatically email out a welcome letter for you to setup your account. Keep a watch on your Inbox for the message titled: "Quarantine reports activated for...". When you receive it, open it up and click on the link to access the spam quarantine login window:



When you click on the link, it will take you to the spam quarantine login window. Please click on the button titled "Retrieve log-in link":

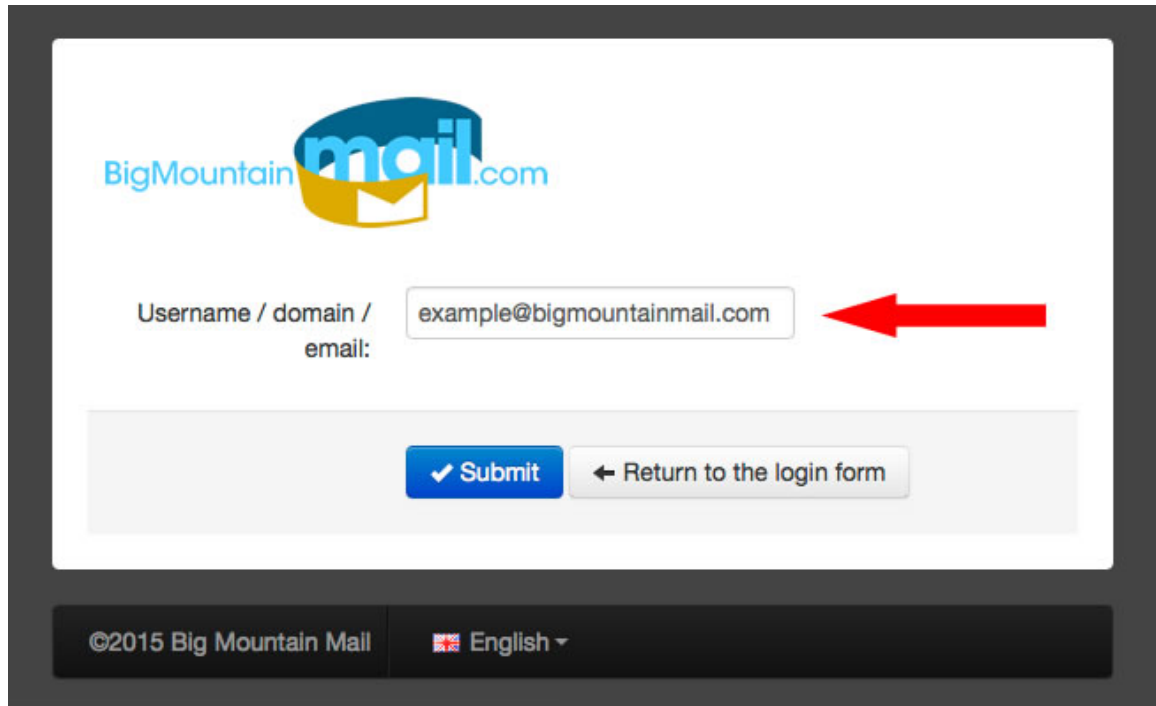

Next, you will enter in your email address and click on “Submit”:



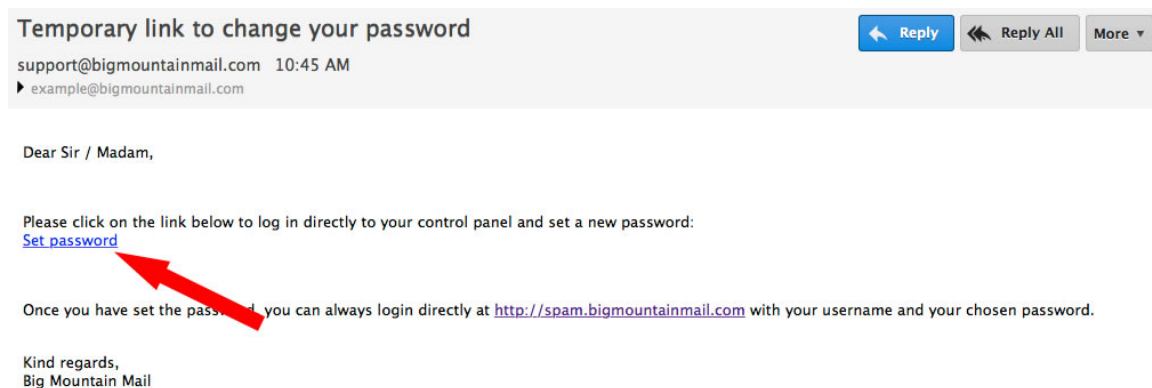

Two Step Authentication

You can enable Two Step Authentication to further increase the security of your account.
This means an additional device (like a mobile phone) will be required in order to log in, so even if someone knows your password they will not be able to take control of your account.
You should be able to use any app that supports the Time-based One-Time Password (TOTP) protocol, including:

Your password is now set and you may log into the spam quarantine control panel at anytime at <http://spam.bigmountainmail.com> to manage your account. You will be able to:

- Search your inbound mail activity in the Log Search.
- View/manage your Spam quarantine.
- View the Incoming Delivery queue.
- Report messages as spam.
- Report messages as not spam.
- Manage your Periodic user report (quarantine report)
- Whitelist sender addresses/domains.
- Blacklist sender addresses/domains.
- Manage your User profile and change your password.

By default, your quarantine reports are emailed daily to you approximately 12:00 am PDT. You can update your preferences by going to Periodic user report. You can change the frequency of your report from daily to weekly or to disable receiving the reports.
